

Newspaper Details

Newspaper Name

- The newspaper's location is often part of its name
- Other words found in newspaper names include: Gazette, Times, Daily, Post, Herald, and Journal

Section Name

- The section name describes the articles in that part of the newspaper
- Sections found in newspapers include: Nation, World, Region, Sports, Business, Lifestyle, and Classifieds

Date

- The newspaper's date

Headlines

- Headlines should describe the article
- They should be short and get people's attention
- Words such as "the" and "a" are left out of the headlines to make them shorter

Sub-titles

- Also called "sub-heading", sub-titles should give more details about the headline
- They should be short

Byline

- The author's name

Article 2,3,& 4, Column 1

- Write a very short article here
- Newspapers sometime group a few short articles about a similar topic in one column
- For example, the articles might tell about the current events or an awards ceremony
